 2. An ANG airman with no MSO will be discharged as a Reserve of the Air Force under ANGR 39-10, unless screening action to the Standby Reserve is accomplished under authority of ANGR 35-08.  
 3. An obligor's period of service while assigned to the ORS or while in a delay status (where no training is authorized and re-

quired) pending entry on his initial ACDUTRA tour under chapter 8 does not count when computing the required five years of military service for transfer to the Standby Reserve under this rule. This service, however, is creditable towards the completion of the member's MSO.  
 ★4. This does not include members who reenlisted under paragraph 7-4c to complete an approved temporary nonmilitary obligation outside the United States under paragraph 14-7.1.
