NOTES:

1. A person in this category who has been designated a Ready Reserve as an exception to paragraph 11-6c, may be retained in Ready Reserve status until he completes 30 years combined active and Reserve service, or ceases to serve on a valid DD Form 1644, "Ready Reserve Service Agreement," under the terms he was initially returned to Ready status.
2. These members will not be redesignated Ready Reserves until return of the initial survey questionnaire and then only if it can be

clearly established that the hardship would not prohibit participation in the Ready Reserve.

3. An ANG airman with no MSO will be discharged as a Reserve of the Air Force under ANGR 39-10.

4. Assign to ISLRS, unless upon voluntary application the member is transferred to the Retired Reserve; or he is discharged upon completion of 30 years' combined active duty and Reserve service.
